

Intermittent closures for ramp and bridge construction

January 8-9 Friday-Saturday 9pm-7am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intermittent ramp closures on southbound I-215 on- and off-ramps
January 4-8 Monday-Friday 10pm-6am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intermittent freeway lane closures on northbound I-215 between Scott Road and McCall Boulevard

New I-215 Southbound Off-Ramp Completed

As part of the project's Stage 1, crews will be striping the new southbound off-ramp on Wednesday, January 6. As part of this work, the existing southbound off-ramp will be closed entirely to allow crews to prepare for the traffic switch.

The new ramp is scheduled to be **open to the public on Thursday, January 7**, weather permitting. This will give way to the new northbound loop on-ramp that is anticipated to be completed in the Spring 2016. Please expect some delays while configuration for the traffic signal at the intersection is completed on Thursday, January 7.


Lane Reductions Continue on Newport Road for Roadway Widening Activities

Night work on eastbound and westbound Newport Road between Haun Road and Antelope Road will continue intermittently at night **Monday-Friday, January 4-8** from 9pm-6am and **Friday-Saturday, January 8-9** from 10-pm-6am for water relocation work and roadway widening.

Please be advised that lanes will temporarily be reduced to one lane in each direction and the left turn pocket will be closed at night.

Please plan ahead in anticipation of the temporary increased traffic in this area. If possible, please avoid the project corridor and use an alternate route. Motorists and pedestrians should slow down and use caution when traveling through work zones, near barricades and equipment.
