WHAT: STORM WATCH – CHAIN CONTROLS

WHERE: RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES

CHAINS REQUIRED FOR SAN BERNARDINO AND RIVERSIDE COUNTY MOUNTAINS

THE FOLLOWING CHAIN REQUIREMENTS ARE IN EFFECT:

<u>SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY</u>		
??	SR 2	Open (No chain requirements)
??	SR 18	Heap's Peak (Rim of the World) to Big Bear (R-3)
??	SR 38	Angelus Oaks to Big Bear (R-2)
??	SR 173	SR-189 to Lake Arrowhead (R-2)
??	SR 330	OPEN in both directions (R-2)
??	I-15	Cajon Pass to Nevada OPEN – no delays at this time.
<u>RIVERSIDE COUNTY</u>		
??	SR 74	Mountain Center (R-1 to R-2)
??	SR 243	SR-74 to Forest Boundary (R-1 to R-2)
??	SR 371	SR-74 (R-1 to R-2)

CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

W:	No Restrictions - Watch for snow on pavement.
R-1:	Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
R-2:	Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
R-3:	Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
