**WHAT: STORM WATCH – CHAIN CONTROLS**

**WHERE: RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES**

## **CHAINS REQUIRED FOR SAN BERNARDINO AND RIVERSIDE COUNTY MOUNTAINS**

Chain restrictions may be set at lower elevations after dark due to icy roads. Carry chains in your vehicle.

### **THE FOLLOWING CHAIN REQUIREMENTS ARE IN EFFECT:**

| <b><u>SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY</u></b> |  |

| • SR 2                              | Open (No chain requirements)                               |
| • SR 18                             | Heap's Peak (Rim of the World) to Big Bear (R-3)           |
| • SR 38                             | Angelus Oaks to Big Bear (R-2)                             |
| • SR 173                            | SR-189 to Lake Arrowhead (R-2)                             |
| • <b>SR 330</b>                     | <b>OPEN in both directions (R-2)</b>                       |
| • <b>I-15</b>                       | <b>Cajon Pass to Nevada OPEN – no delays at this time.</b> |
| <b><u>RIVERSIDE COUNTY</u></b>      |  |
| • SR 243                            | Lake Fulmor to Twin Pines Ranch Road (R-1 to R-2)          |

### **CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:**

|             |  |
|-------------|--|
| <b>W:</b>   | <b>No Restrictions</b> - Watch for snow on pavement.   |
| <b>R-1:</b> | Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle. |
| <b>R-2:</b> | Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.                                  |
| <b>R-3:</b> | Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.  |
