## Emergency Project Closures on Interstate 215 Overcrossing

**RIVERSIDE** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues an emergency project to repair part of the southbound I-215 bridge deck that crosses over Chicago Avenue in Riverside.

The eastbound SR 91 to the southbound I-215 connector will remain closed until the emergency repair is completed to help ensure the safety of workers and the public.

The outside two lanes of southbound I-215 will also remain closed from just south of the 60/91/215 interchange to south of the Chicago undercrossing. The carpool lane in this area is open to all traffic to help reduce congestion.

Thursday night, January 13, the contractor will pour concrete, which will require closing some additional lanes. Please see the table below for closure information.
