## STATE ROUTE 66 PAVING PROJECT UNDERWAY

**SAN BERNARDINO**-The California Department of Transportation is currently paving a segment of State Route 66 (Foothill Blvd) in San Bernardino. The number one lane (fast lane) in each direction, between Pepper Avenue and the Lytle Creek Bridge, is being repaved for a distance of one mile.

Grinding operations will conclude this week and paving will take place next Tuesday, January 19, 2016 and Wednesday, January 20, 2016. Work hours are 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

One lane is available in each direction. Traffic will not be permitted to cross the hot asphalt. Motorists are advised to follow the posted advisory signs.
