STATE ROUTE 91 (SR-91) HOV PROJECT JANUARY FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES BETWEEN CENTRAL AND 14TH

RIVERSIDE – Caltrans, District 8 continues construction on the six mile, \$232 million high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane project on SR-91 through downtown Riverside. There will be **full freeway closures of SR-91 between Central Avenue and 14th Street**. These closures are necessary to construct the Pachappa Railroad Bridge across the freeway.

The closures will take place as follows:
