INTERSTATE 15 (I-15) SIERRA AVENUE INTERCHANGE PROJECT 10-DAY CLOSURE OF SIERRA AVENUE RAMPS

SAN BERNARDINO-- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the northbound I-15/Sierra Avenue off-ramp and southbound I-15/Sierra Avenue on-ramp beginning January 26, 2015 at 5:00 a.m. for 10-days as part of the I-15/Sierra Avenue Interchange Project.

The \$2.5 million project, which was awarded to All American Asphalt Company, Inc. of Corona and broke ground in November 2014, will signalize the northbound and southbound I-15 ramp intersections at Sierra Avenue in Fontana. It will also widen Sierra Avenue from one lane to two lanes from Riverside Avenue to north of the southbound I-15 off-ramp, perform drainage improvements, widen the northbound and southbound off-ramps, as well as extend the existing Sierra Avenue sewer line.

The closures are needed to perform the work necessary to widen the ramps—construct concrete, pave, construct sidewalks, construct wheelchair ramps, etc.

Detours will be in place at all times, so please follow all posted signs. Motorists may also consider using alternate routes when available.
