## INTERSTATE 215 WIDENING PROJECT

**Full Northbound Freeway Closure**  
**Monday, February 8 and Tuesday, February 9**  
**12 a.m. to 5 a.m.**

**Full Southbound Freeway Closure**  
**Wednesday, February 10 and Thursday, February 11**  
**12 a.m. to 5 a.m.**

**San Bernardino** – As part of the I-215 Widening Project, Caltrans and the contractors will be closing the north and southbound I-215 at Highland Avenue for bridge demolition. In order to keep you moving and on time the following detours have been provided below.

- **Northbound I-215** – Monday, February 8 and Tuesday, February 9  
12:00 a.m. - 5:00 a.m.  
Exit Muscupiabe and follow the detour signs to re-enter at 27<sup>th</sup> Street
- **Southbound I-215** – Wednesday, February 10 and Thursday, February 11  
12:00 a.m. – 5:00 a.m.  
Exit 27<sup>th</sup> Street and follow the detour signs to re-enter at SR-259 on-ramp
