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Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Update #43

Riverside County – Construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project continues next week. Work next week includes paving, k-rail placement, shoulder paving, striping and bridge demolition. Ramps and lanes will be closed as needed within the dates and times shown below.
