PROJECT BEGINS TO ADD AUXILIARY LANES TO INTERSTATE 10 IN FONTANA & RIALTO

San Bernardino – Construction begins tonight to widen off-ramps and add an auxiliary lane to eastbound and westbound Interstate 10 (I-10) from just east of the Etiwanda Avenue Overcrossing in Fontana to just west of the Riverside Avenue Overcrossing in Rialto. The project was awarded to C. C. Myers, Inc. for approximately \$10.7 million on October 12, 2010. The work is expected to reduce congestion and improve safety by reducing weaving.

Work this week will include restriping, adding barriers and grinding pavement. Two to three lanes, as well as on- and off-ramps will be closed at times during construction. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Please see the work schedule in the table below.
