CALTRANS CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Week of February 6, 2012

SR-91 Mainline

WHAT: Drainage work (removal/installation) continues on both EB and WB sides of the freeway. Compaction and paving of the roadway (lane addition) will continue to take place through the span of the project behind the K-rails. This work will be done throughout the day and night. Residents may experience noise and vibrations as a result of construction.

WHAT: EB 91 Express Lanes will be closed for crews to install the gantry structure.

11:00 p.m., Saturday, February 11 th – 6:00 p.m., Sunday, February 12 th .	Eastbound SR-91 Express Lanes. Mainline lanes will not be affected.

Imperial Highway (Imperial Highway bridge) – NOISE ALERT

WHAT: Daytime pile driving will occur at Imperial Highway bridge from 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. as part of establishing the foundation for bridge widening. **Residents and businesses are advised that the pile driving operation and the use of heavy construction equipment could be noisy and cause vibrations.**

Weir Canyon Road (Weir Canyon bridge) – NOISE ALERT

WHAT: Daytime pile driving will occur at Weir Canyon bridge from 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. as part of establishing the foundation for bridge widening. SB Weir Canyon Road, Lane #1 will be closed from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. **Residents and businesses are advised that the pile driving operation and the use of heavy construction equipment could be noisy and cause vibrations.**

Daily, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Monday, February 6 th – Friday, February 10 th .	Southbound Weir Canyon Road, Lane #1, from Weir Canyon westbound SR-91 off-ramp to eastbound SR-91 off-ramp.
