## State Route 60 Safety Project Starts Sunday

**Beaumont** – A project to improve safety along State Route (SR) 60 in the Badlands area starts Sunday. The project will add rumble strips on the inside and outside shoulders, make the lane striping more visible, and install barrier markers on the top and sides of the concrete median barrier. Work will start just east of Gilman Springs Road and end about a mile west of Jack Rabbit Trail.

The project was awarded to Cal Stripe, Inc. on December 19, 2008 for \$144,480. Construction is expected to last until early spring 2009, weather permitting.

Please see the construction schedule for this week and next below. Alternate lanes will be closed. At least one lane will be open in each direction during construction.
