PROJECT UPDATE WIRELESS VEHICLE DETECTION SYSTEMS

RIVERSIDE COUNTY –Caltrans continues installation of a new wireless vehicle detection system on Inland Empire freeways that analyzes traffic data faster and will ultimately afford faster traffic alerts for the public. Work continues on Interstate 215 next week. Please see below for the project location.
