



SR-74 Safety Improvement Project Traffic Advisory

Ortega Highway to Remain Open at Night February 15 to February 20, 2008

WHAT: Full nightly closures on Ortega Highway will be lifted from February 15 to February 20, 2008 in observance of the Presidents Day holiday weekend. During this time, continuous flagging operations will be in effect all day through the current SR-74 Safety Improvement Project area. The road in the project area will be down to one lane, approximately one mile east of the San Juan Creek bridge.

With safety as Caltrans number one priority, Caltrans asks that motorists be mindful of the construction equipment and crews, and to follow the decreased traffic speeds posted through the project area. Fines are being doubled in the construction zone and are being strictly enforced.

WHEN: *Friday, February 15 from 8:30 p.m. through Wednesday, February 20 at 8:30 p.m.* There will be 24-hour continuous flagging in place with one lane open in the construction zone. Full night closures will resume daily on Wednesday, February 20 from 8:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.

WHERE: Approximately one mile east of the San Juan Canyon bridge
