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Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Update #46

Riverside County – Construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project continues next week. Work will include paving, k-rail placement, shoulder paving, striping and bridge demolition. Ramps and lanes will be closed as needed within the dates and times shown below.

Eastbound SR-60 connector to eastbound I-10	Until further notice	24 hours	One lane only as ½ of the connector is rebuilt. Expect delays.
Eastbound I-10 to westbound SR-60	Monday – Friday nights	10 p.m. – 4 a.m.	Full Connector Closure
Westbound SR-60 from 6 th Street on-ramp	March 1 – March 15	24-hour closure	Full Ramp Closure for asphalt replacement
Eastbound and westbound I-10 from County Line Road to Pennsylvania Ave.	Monday – Friday nights	10 p.m. – 4 a.m.	One to two lanes will be open at all times. (Each closure will be 3 miles or less.)
Eastbound and westbound I-10 from County Line Road to Pennsylvania Ave.	Monday – Friday	7 a.m. – 3 p.m.	Right shoulder in various locations
