STATE ROUTE 91 HOV PROJECT UPDATE ARLINGTON AVENUE TRAFFIC SWITCH

Riverside – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the six-mile, \$232 million high-occupancy-vehicle (HOV) lane project on State Route 91. Construction is moving forward to Arlington Avenue next week. Arlington Avenue will be lowered in order to increase the vertical clearance and widen the Arlington Avenue overpass on SR 91. The overpass widening will take place concurrent with the road lowering. There will also be various permanent traffic changes affecting Arlington and Indiana Avenues. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during construction.

Setting of K-rail and striping will begin on Sunday night, February 24 at 9:00 p.m. Beginning at 5 a.m. on Monday, January 25th all of the Arlington Avenue traffic will be moved to the north side of the street. There will then be one lane available in each direction and business access on Arlington and Indiana Avenues will be maintained. The eastbound Arlington Avenue on-ramp will also be closed for approximately ten days. This stage of the construction will continue until late/spring early summer when all traffic will then be switched to the south side of Arlington Avenue while work commences on the north side.

Use alternate routes whenever possible and schedule extra time for travel through the construction project.
