State Route 60 Safety Project Update #2

Beaumont – A project to improve safety along State Route (SR) 60 in the Badlands area continues next week. Construction workers are adding rumble strips on the inside and outside shoulders, making the lane striping more visible, and installing barrier markers on the top and sides of the concrete median barrier. Work starts just east of Gilman Springs Road and ends about a mile west of Jack Rabbit Trail.

Please see the construction schedule for next week below. Alternate lanes will be closed. At least one lane will be open in each direction during construction.
