BE PREPARED – BRING CHAINS TO THE MOUNTAINS

SR-38 from Angelus Oaks to Big Bear Dam (SR-18)	Chain Control R-2	Snow/Ice	Unknown
SR-173 from SR-189 to Grass Valley Rd.	Chain Control R-2	Snow/Ice	Unknown
SR-330 from Upper Passing Lane to SR-18	Chain Control R-2	Snow/Ice	Unknown
SR-243 from Pine Cove to Forest Boundary	Chain Control R-1	Snow/Ice	Unknown

CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

- W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
- R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
- R-2: Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
- R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.

This alert will be updated when new information is available in regards to chain control. Snow chains can be purchased at retail department stores, sporting goods, and auto parts stores. Mountain weather can change dramatically on very short notice.
