EB/WB State Route 91 from SR-241 to Weir Canyon Road Full Freeway Closures March 10th and 11th; March 17th and 18th

WHAT: Full freeway closures for SR-91 will take place for crews to remove gantry structures.

Changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists of the construction activity and available detour routes.

WB 91 Full closure from SR-241 to Weir Canyon Road, including WB 91 Express Lanes. Detour: Exit at Gypsum Canyon Road, right on Gypsum Canyon Road, left on La Palma Avenue, left on Yorba Linda Boulevard to WB 91 on-ramp.
11 p.m., Friday, March 16 th to 7 a.m., Saturday, March 17 th .	EB 91 Express Lanes only. Mainline lanes will not be affected.
11 p.m., Saturday, March 17 th to 7 a.m., Sunday, March 18 th AND 11 p.m., Sunday, March 18 th to 4 a.m., Monday, March 19 th .	EB 91 Full closure from Weir Canyon Road to SR-241, including EB 91 Express Lanes. Detour: Exit at Weir Canyon Road, right on Weir Canyon Road, left on Santa Ana Canyon Road, left on Gypsum Canyon Road to EB 91 on-ramp.
