Storm Repairs on National Trails Highway to begin

National Trails Highway experienced roadway erosion damage as well as drainage culvert structural damage during the December 2010 storms. The roadway was temporarily closed due to the damage but was later reopened after temporary repairs were completed and K-rail installed.

Permanent repairs are now scheduled to begin. National Trails will therefore be closed to through traffic from Vista Road to Frontier Road and from Hodge Road to Hinkley Road from February 28th through March 3rd 2011, weather permitting, to complete the permanent repairs. Local residents and business owners will have access to their properties. A full closure with no entrance will be on National Trails Highway from Frontier Road to Hodge Road due to more extensive work that involves replacing the drainage structure and repaving the damaged section of road. Repairs are expected to be completed by March 3rd.

These repairs will improve the road condition for all residents and travelers on this important highway in San Bernardino County.
