## INTERSTATE 10 REDLANDS PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will began work on the \$26 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Replacement Project on Monday night, March 7<sup>th</sup>. The project replaces concrete pavement in both directions of I-10 between Ford Street in the City of Redlands and Live Oak Canyon Road in the City of Yucaipa.

East and Westbound I-10 will be reduced to two lanes, nightly. Eastbound will be reduced to two lanes from 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. nightly. Westbound will be reduced to two lanes from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. nightly. The closures are necessary to prepare the center median for the crossover lane installation. The work will take place Monday through Friday as detailed below.

The details of work for **March 7 to March 18, 2016** are as follows:
