GUARDRAIL PROJECT BEGINS ON INTERSTATE 10 AND STATE ROUTES 62 & 243

Riverside County – Construction begins on Monday, March 14, to upgrade metal beam guardrail and bridge connections at the following locations:

- Interstate 10 (I-10) – Dillon Road to the Colorado River Bridge
- State Route 62 – Rice Wasteway Bridge to 12.7 miles west of the Arizona border
- State Route 243 – About 1 mile north of the south entrance to Keewild Forest to 15.7 miles south of Banning city limits

The project was awarded to Modern Alloys, Inc. for \$5 million. Crews will begin work next week at the locations and times shown in the table below:

LOCATION	DAYS & TIMES	LANE CLOSURES
Westbound I-10 starting in Blythe	Mondays – Fridays 6 a.m. – 7 p.m.	One lane will be open at all times
State Route 62 from Rice Wasteway Bridge to 12.7 miles west of the Arizona border	Monday, March 14 & Tuesday, March 15 6 a.m. – 7 p.m.	One-way traffic control with flaggers. Expect delays.

This alert will be updated when work begins on State Route 243 and eastbound I-10. The work is expected to last until late 2012. Please follow all advisory signs and **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE**.
