Emergency Project--State Route 74 (SR-74) near the Cranston Fire Station

Hemet – Caltrans and its contractor, Skanska, of Los Angeles, Calif. will begin work tomorrow on an emergency project on SR-74 near the Cranston Fire Station. The work will take place from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; work will take place this weekend during the same hours and will continue next week.

The \$750,000 emergency project is needed to stabilize the slope, which was undermined during the recent rain event. The project includes excavation, structure back fill, debris removal, removing and replacing existing pavement, slope stabilization and installation of a perforated under drain.

Reversible, one-way traffic control will be in effect during the work hours. Please follow all posted construction signs, as well as the instructions of flaggers on-site.
