


# CALTRANS COMMUTER ALERT

## EB State Route 91 from SR-241 to Weir Canyon Road Full Freeway Closure – **UPDATED** March 24<sup>th</sup> (and 25<sup>th</sup> if necessary)

**WHAT:** The full freeway closure for EB SR-91 that was scheduled to take place on March 17<sup>th</sup> has been **rescheduled for March 24<sup>th</sup>** in anticipation of inclement weather. The closure is needed for crews to remove gantry structures. Changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists of the construction activity and available detour routes.

*Disclaimer: Due to unforeseen operational factors or inclement weather, these dates and times may change.*

Then from EB 91 exit Green River Road, left on Green River Road to WB 91 on-ramp, to SB 241. |
