TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION PROJECT ON STATE ROUTE 60 TO BEGIN NEXT WEEK

SAN BERNARDINO-- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on the \$1 million State Route 60 (SR-60)/Mission Boulevard Traffic Signal Project next week. The project will install traffic signals, realign the left turn lane and widen the ramp at the intersection of the SR-60 westbound on-ramp and Mission Boulevard near Mira Loma.

The contractor, Powell Constructors, Inc., will work on Monday-Wednesday from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. to install construction area signs and will close the westbound Mission Boulevard/Van Buren Boulevard on-ramp on Wednesday-Friday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Additionally, one lane of Mission Boulevard/Van Buren Boulevard will be closed at SR-60 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night next week.

The project will improve the safety of the intersection and is estimated to be complete in January 2016.
