UPDATE

WORK ON SR-62 (COLORADO RIVER BRIDGE)

California/Arizona State Line – Caltrans has begun drilling for samples on State Route 62 (SR-62) on the Colorado River Bridge in preparation for a future bridge-widening project. The work will continue to take place over the few weeks as follows:

- ☞☞ March 20, 21 & 22 (Tuesday through Thursday) from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- ☞☞ April 3, 4 & 5 (Tuesday through Thursday) from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- ☞☞ April 10, 11 & 12 (Tuesday through Thursday) from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- ☞☞ April 17, 18 & 19 (Tuesday through Thursday) from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- ☞☞ April 24, 25 & 26 (Tuesday through Thursday) from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

During the work hours, traffic on the bridge will be reduced to one lane. Flagging will be used to move traffic through the work zone one direction at a time. Delays may be expected for up to thirty minutes. No work will take place at night or on weekends.

The schedule for the completion of the drilling work after March 22 will be released when finalized. For information on other Caltrans roadwork, please go to our website at caltrans8.info.
