STATE ROUTE 91 GREEN RIVER ROAD BRIDGE UPDATE

Corona- Work has begun on the \$21 million bridge improvement project. Beginning Monday, March 26, nighttime lane closures will take place on SR-91 in order to set K rails (protective concrete barriers) and to re-stripe the lanes on the 91. These initial closures will establish the project limits and provide work areas for the crews. Both the westbound exit ramp and the east bound exit ramp will be closed for one night during the “set up” phase of this project. SEMA Construction, the contractor, will be able to work behind the barriers once the safe work zones are established.

East bound	SR-91 Main line to set barriers	Friday, March 30 8 pm to 7 am	Full closure of the 2 outside lanes
