Nighttime Full Closures of Eastbound 91 at Maple Street, March 28 and 29

The 91 Project in Corona will require nighttime full closures of eastbound 91 near Maple Street. The closures will take place Monday, March 28 and Tuesday, March 29 from 11 pm to 4 am both nights.

The closures will allow crews to continue construction of the support structure for the westbound Maple Street on-ramp bridge. Crews began work on this structure during the 91 Steer Clear 55-hour closure last month.

“Closing the eastbound 91 will help provide safe working conditions for crews and motorists while the support structure is being built,” said Riverside County Transportation Commission Executive Director Anne Mayer.

During these closures, motorists will be detoured to the Maple Street off-ramp to reconnect to eastbound 91 using the Paseo Grande on-ramp.

This construction work is subject to change based on weather, field conditions or other operational factors.

During this time and throughout construction, motorists are reminded to follow the posted speed limit within the 91 Project construction zone, allow extra travel time, follow detour signs, and carpool or use public transit, when feasible.

The 91 Project is adding regular lanes, tolled express lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15. Improvements to interchanges, ramps, lanes and surface streets also will be

made along the 91 between the Riverside County/Orange County Line in Corona and Pierce Street in Riverside. The new lanes are expected to open in 2017.
