SAN BERNARDINO – California Department of Transportation & San Bernardino Associated Governments are continuing work throughout the project corridor, which spans from Orange Show Rd. to University Pkwy. Crews will continue work on various lanes and ramps and the 9th St. bridge. Please note that lane and ramp closures are alternating with no two consecutive ramps being closed at one time.
