WORK SCHEDULE ON I-10 AND I-215

San Bernardino, Grand Terrace and Redlands – Caltrans continues the \$11.5 million project to install a fiber communications network on I-10 and I-215. Lane and ramp closures will occur in the San Bernardino, Grand Terrace and Redlands area. This commuter alert will be updated if any changes occur.

Eastbound I-10 at Tippecanoe on ramp	Tuesday through Friday 03/25 – 04/04	9 PM to 6 AM	Closure of Tippecanoe on ramp
