PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT BEGINS ON INTERSTATE 15 IN RANCHO CUCAMONGA AND FONTANA

San Bernardino – Construction begins this week on the 9-mile project which will provide pavement rehabilitation on Interstate 15 (I-15) from the 7th Street undercrossing in the City of Rancho Cucamonga to the Sierra Avenue undercrossing in the City of Fontana. The project was awarded to Griffith/Coffman Joint Venture, Inc. for approximately \$83 million on February 16, 2012. The work includes rehabilitation of portions of the No. 3 and No. 4 lanes in both directions, rehabilitation of the outside shoulder and widening of the inside shoulder. The work is expected to improve the ride quality, extend pavement life, and improve facility operation and safety.

The contractor will be installing construction area signs tomorrow morning and may close some lanes on both NB/SB sides in the evening this week. Follow us on Twitter for closures and scheduling at www.twitter.com/caltrans8. Please see the work schedule in the table below.
