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INTERSTATE 40 PAVING PROJECT BEGINS

Interstate 40 near Essex – Motorists will start to see construction activities on Interstate 40 (I-40) near Essex as Caltrans begins a 30-mile pavement rehabilitation project. The contract for this \$44 million project was awarded to Granite Construction Company.

Initial work will consist of paving and sign installation. In order to keep you moving and on time, we have provided the most recent work schedule below.
