STATE ROUTE 91 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT UPDATE NIGHT CLOSURES

Yorba Linda -- Work began on the \$14.2 million pavement rehabilitation project along State Route 91 (SR-91). Beginning Saturday, March 31st nightly closures are scheduled to re-stripe lanes, conduct bridge repair and install new drainage systems from the State Route 241 exit ramp to just west of the Coal Canyon under-crossing.

The contractor, All American Asphalt will conduct rolling closures with one to two lanes open at all times. **Please refer to the closure chart below for specific times and locations:**
