## CALTRANS Performs Interstate 40 (I-40) Bridge Replacement Work

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) begins work on I-40 near Essex in San Bernardino County on April 6<sup>th</sup>. The bridge replacement project, totaling \$20 million, is to be performed on Haller Wash Bridge, Rojo Wash Bridge, and Clipper Valley Wash Bridge.

Detours are to be in place for the duration of the work. 2 lanes from the westbound direction will be detoured to one lane on the eastbound side by way of constructed median crossover. Work takes place from Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The bridge work will ensure operational efficiency, safe passage, and longevity for all users. Project benefits include improved access for traffic and new pavement with extended life requiring less maintenance.
