NEW PAVEMENT FOR INTERSTATE 10 (I-10) & STATE ROUTE 60 (SR-60)

SAN BERNARDINO/RIVERSIDE – Caltrans, District 8 is rehabilitating the pavement in various areas on I-10 and SR-60 to give motorists a smoother ride during their commute. Four projects have been initiated to rehabilitate I-10 and SR-60 over the next four years.

In a few weeks motorists can expect to see construction crews working on I-10 between the Los Angeles County line in the City of Montclair to SR-38 in the City of Redlands. The \$34 million I-10 project, awarded to J. McLoughlin Engineering Company Inc., will replace various slabs primarily in the number 3 and 4 lanes which receive heavy truck traffic. The project will also replace asphalt on various ramps and shoulders. Work will start at the Los Angeles County line and move east. The project is expected to last approximately two years.

In addition, primarily the number 2 and 3 lanes on SR-60 will also see various slab replacements. The \$281 thousand SR-60 project was awarded to Chumo Construction Inc. The slab replacements include both directions of SR-60 from Euclid Avenue in the City of Chino to County Village Road in the City of Jurupa Valley. This project is expected to last approximately two months.

Changeable message signs will be strategically placed throughout the Inland Empire to remind motorists of the work. Please plan your route before you go. Expect minor delays if you must travel either stretch of highway.
