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GUARDRAIL & BRIDGE REPAIR PROJECTS CONTINUE ON I-10 UPDATE #2

Riverside County – Construction crews continue to upgrade metal beam guardrail and bridge connections on Interstate 10 (I-10) from Dillon Road to the Colorado River Bridge. The entire project also includes work on State Route 62, which has already been completed, and future work on State Route 243. The work is expected to last until late 2012. This alert will be updated as the locations change. Next week, work will take place at the location and times shown in the table below.

Eastbound & Westbound I-10 between Eagle Mountain Rd and Colorado River Bridge	Mondays – Fridays 6 a.m. – 7 p.m.	Various lanes will be closed.

A separate project to rehabilitate bridges at 8 locations along I-10 near Desert Center also continues next week. This project is expected to last until mid-May with the same schedule each week as shown below.

The closure may be up to 2 miles long and may last up to 72 hours during the times shown to the left.
Westbound I-10 from 3 miles west of Eagle Mountain Rd. to 5 miles east of Hayfield Rd.	Monday nights at 11:59 p.m.	Thursday nights at 11:59 p.m.
