TRAFFIC ADVISORY: INTERSTATE 10 WESTBOUND WIDENING PROJECT

Yucaipa & Redlands, CA – SANBAG and project partners are working together to widen Interstate 10 between Live Oak Canyon Road in Yucaipa and Ford Street in Redlands. The project will add a general purpose lane to approximately 3.5 miles of westbound Interstate 10.

Freeway lane closures are planned for barrier screen installation and excavation work along center median as well as inspection of the concrete roadway.

No detour will be required, since at least one travel lane is expected to remain open at all times.
Mon., April 11 or Tues., April 12 or Wed., April 13 9 pm to 4 am Due to inclement weather forecasts, a short-term ramp closure will occur on only one of the dates listed above.	Westbound Interstate 10 Yucaipa Boulevard off-ramp	During this closure, motorists will be detoured to the Wabash Avenue off-ramp, and directed onto eastbound I-10 on-ramp and exit at the Yucaipa Blvd. off-ramp. Detour signs will be posted to direct motorists through the area.
