UNITED STATES ROUTE 95 (US-95) SAFETY PROJECT

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) plans to begin work on April 13 to install ground-in rumble strips on US 95 along the centerline (passing and no passing zones) and along the outside shoulders near Needles from Interstate 40 (I-40) to the Nevada State Line.

This section of the highway is a two-lane conventional road. The traffic along the majority of this segment is separated by double yellow lines. This segment was identified in a safety monitoring report and due to the number of cross centerline accidents, this rumble strip project has been approved by the Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Headquarters Office of Traffic Safety.

Work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM – 3:30 PM, and the project is scheduled to be completed at the beginning of May depending on weather. There will be one-mile long full directional closures during work hours with flaggers for traffic control. Please allow extra time if you are travelling through the work areas.
