Project to Add Exit Number Signs on I-10 & I-15 Begins

San Bernardino & Riverside Counties – Work will start Sunday night, April 12, to add exit number signs on Interstate 10 (I-10) and Interstate 15 (I-15). The project extends from the Los Angeles county line to the Arizona state line on I-10. On I-15, the project begins at the San Diego county line and ends 2 miles south of Limonite Avenue.

Closures are scheduled for the locations and times shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Ramp closures are expected to last about 30 minutes. On the main lanes of the freeway, closures will be short and alternate between lanes.

| North and southbound I-15 from San Diego County Line to 6 th Street, south of State Route 60 | Monday, April 12 – Friday, April 17 | 11 p.m. – 4 a.m. | #2, 3 & 4 lanes alternately | Intermittent full closures |

Caltrans asks that you obey all advisory signs and **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE**. Construction is expected to last approximately 45 days. This “Alert” will continue to be updated with new information throughout the project.
