Interstate 40 Bridge Work Continues

San Bernardino County – Caltrans continues work on a \$3 million project on Interstate 40 (I-40) to repair girders on eight bridges. The work consists of installing shear keys to stop/delay progression of girder cracks.

Work will begin April 17, 2009 at the Van Winkle Bridge (7 miles east of Kelbaker Road) and will be a long-term lane closure affecting one lane across the bridge. **Please note:** The one lane available will provide for a 16' width. Any oversize loads should contact Caltrans Transportation Permits at (909) 383-4637. In order to keep you moving and on time, we have provided the work schedule below.
