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STATE ROUTE 91 HOV PROJECT UPDATE **WORK TO BEGIN ON MADISON STREET BRIDGE**

Riverside— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the six-mile, \$232 million high-occupancy-vehicle (HOV) lane project on State Route (SR) 91 through downtown Riverside. Work is now scheduled to begin on the Madison Street bridge on Friday, April 22. The bridge is being widened in order to construct the new HOV lanes.

Madison Street will be re-striped beginning on Monday, April 22 which will reduce traffic to one lane plus turn pockets in each direction. This lane reduction will occur between the on and off-ramps on the Madison Street bridge. Pedestrian access across the bridge will continue to be maintained during construction. The eastbound on-ramp to SR-91 will also be closed for ten days beginning April 22. Detours will be available.

Pile driving is scheduled to begin on Thursday, April 25th as part of the bridge widening and will continue for approximately ten working days. At this time, the work is scheduled to be conducted between the hours of 4:00 PM through 11:59 PM. All work is subject to weather conditions.

Please drive carefully through the construction zone, observe speed limits, and obey any instructions requested by the construction crew.
