BE WORK ZONE ALERT!

PAVEMENT REHABILITATION BEGINS ON STATE ROUTE 60 WITH 55-HOUR WEEKEND CLOSURES

SAN BERNARDINO – Caltrans, District 8 will begin work on Tuesday, April 21, to rehabilitate various sections of pavement on State Route 60 (SR 60) from the Los Angeles County Line in Chino Hills to Valley Way in Jurupa. This project is one of several in the region to replace aging and damaged slabs to provide a smoother and more efficient ride to motorists.

The project will use nighttime lane closures Monday through Friday, from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. In addition to the nighttime work, there will be **several 55-hour weekend** lane closure periods through the end of 2015.

The details for the first two 55-hour weekend lane closures are as follows:

Motorists are advised to avoid using SR 60 between SR 71 and I-15 during the weekend work. Use alternate routes such as I-10 or SR 210. The #1 lane and HOV (Carpool) lane (2 of 5 lanes) will be available to traffic during the closures. Advanced warning signs will be placed strategically to inform motorists of closures. **HEAVY DELAYS ARE EXPECTED** so plan ahead, know before you go, and rideshare if possible.
