


Construction Activity, April 18-23, 2016

Intermittent closures for ramp and bridge construction at Newport Rd.

April 18-22 Monday-Friday 8pm-5am	Intermittent freeway lane closures on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ southbound I-215 between Scott Road and McCall Boulevard
April 22-23 Friday-Saturday 9pm-7am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Intermittent ramp closures on southbound I-215 on- and off-ramps
April 18-22 Monday-Friday 10pm-6am	Intermittent freeway lane closures on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ northbound I-215 between Scott Road and McCall Boulevard
April 22-23 Friday-Saturday 10pm-7am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Intermittent ramp closures on northbound I-215 on- and off-ramps
April 18-22 Wednesday-Friday 9pm-6am	Intermittent lane reductions on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Newport Road between Haun Road and Antelope Road

Menifee Merge on Newport Road Bridge

The City of Menifee and the Riverside County Transportation Department is advising motorists to be aware of traffic pattern changes around the I-215 and Newport Road interchange.

Construction crews demolished the south side of the bridge on April 8-13. Reconstruction of the bridge will continue for approximately six months. Newport Road traffic has been shifted onto the north side of the bridge and the traffic merge will run in both directions from April through October.

In this temporary configuration, the eastbound traffic will include two through lanes, one dedicated left-turn lane for the northbound I-215 on-ramp, and one dedicated right-turn lane for the southbound I-215 on-ramp. Westbound traffic will include two through lanes, and one dedicated right-turn lane for the northbound I-215 on-ramp.

Please plan ahead in anticipation of the temporary increased traffic in this area. If possible, please avoid the project corridor and use an alternate route. Motorists and pedestrians should slow down and use caution when traveling through work zones, near barricades and equipment.
