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Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Revised Update #54

Riverside County – Construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project continues next week. Work will include paving, k-rail placement, shoulder paving, striping and bridge demolition. Ramps and lanes will be closed as needed within the dates and times shown below. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Ramp closures will be alternated as work is completed. **Rain has delayed the opening of the 6th Street on-ramp to I-10. The contractor expects to re-open the on-ramp on Sunday, April 25.**
