STATUS UPDATE FOR OPERATION "I-215 SPRING STING"

SAN BERNARDINO – Caltrans District 8 would like to thank the public for their cooperation throughout the "I-215 Spring Sting" closures. Due to the precision planning and preparation by the contractor, Ames Construction, Inc., in conjunction with Stinger Bridge and Iron, the success of the railroad bridge work has not required Saturday night closures of I-215 to date between Riverside and San Bernardino.

There is one more week of closures to place the fourth truss of the new railroad bridge. Following is the closure information:

- I-215 between Iowa Avenue and Barton Road

- **FULL CLOSURE OF NORTH AND SOUTHBOUND I-215**
Friday and Saturday April 25 and 26
11:30 p.m. to 11:30 a.m. the following day
- Full closure of northbound I-215
Wednesday and Thursday, April 23 and 24
11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following day
