## 55-HOUR WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE FOR PAVEMENT REHABILITATION ON STATE ROUTE 60

**SAN BERNARDINO** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close lanes this weekend for pavement rehabilitation on various sections of State Route 60 (SR-60). Lane closures will begin 10:00 p.m. Friday, April 24, 2015 through 5:00 a.m. Monday, April 27, 2015 from the Los Angeles County Line in Chino Hills to Valley Way in Jurupa. This project is one of several in the region to replace aging and damaged slabs to provide a smoother and more efficient ride for motorists.

The details for the first of two 55-hour weekend lane closures are as follows:

In addition to the **55-hour weekend** lane closures, the project will use nighttime lane closures Monday through Friday, from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. The project is expected to be completed by the end of 2015.

Motorists are advised to avoid using SR 60 between SR 71 and I-15 during the weekend work. Use alternate routes such as I-10 or SR 210. The #1 lane and HOV (Carpool) lane (2 of 5 lanes) will be available to traffic during the closures. Advanced warning signs will be placed strategically to inform motorists of closures. **HEAVY DELAYS ARE EXPECTED** so plan ahead, know before you go, and rideshare if possible.
