LAST WEEKEND OF “SPRING” STING

SAN BERNARDINO – Caltrans is informing motorists that this is the last weekend of I-215 “Spring” Sting. Both directions of Interstate 215 (I-215) **will be closed** Friday night and possibly Saturday night, April 25 and 26, from 11:30 p.m. to 11:30 a.m. to install the final railroad bridge truss just south of Barton Road.

Again, Caltrans District 8 would like to thank the public for their cooperation throughout the “I-215 Spring Sting” closures. The precision planning and preparation by Ames Construction, Inc. and Stinger Bridge and Iron has made this operation a great success. This “out-of-the-box” thinking and innovation to erect two railroad bridges on site and then install them over four consecutive weekends saved motorists months of full closures and long term traffic impacts.

Following is the closure information for the final spring weekend:

- I-215 between Iowa Avenue and Barton Road
