US 395 Rehabilitation/Rumble Strip Project Begins

Adelanto – A project to widen the median and shoulders, install median and shoulder rumble strips, and construct turnouts will begin Monday, April 29th. Signs have been present through the area informing motorists of the coming project. Sully Miller Contracting Company was awarded the project at a cost of \$21.3 million. The Project limits are approximately 8 miles north of State Route 18 to approximately 11 miles south of State Route 58/Kramer Junction.

The contractor will be conducting flagging operations (pilot car) starting Monday, April 29 from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. the following morning. The nightly closures will last between four to six weeks. One lane will remain open at all times.
