UPDATE: SHOULDER WIDENING PROJECT ON US-395 FROM KRAMER JUNCTION TO KRAMER HILLS

SAN BERNARDINO— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue the safety operation from Kramer Junction to Kramer Hills on United States Highway 395 (US-395). This \$40 million project will include a median buffer, widening shoulders to state standards, and installation of a centerline and rumble strips.

During the project, there will be alternating lanes closures at various locations in both directions on US-395. *Closures will take place on Friday, April 26 and Monday, April 29.* There will be flagging operations and a pilot car to assist in managing lane closures.

Please remember to reduce your speed in the work zone. Be advised, weather conditions may affect the completion date of this project.

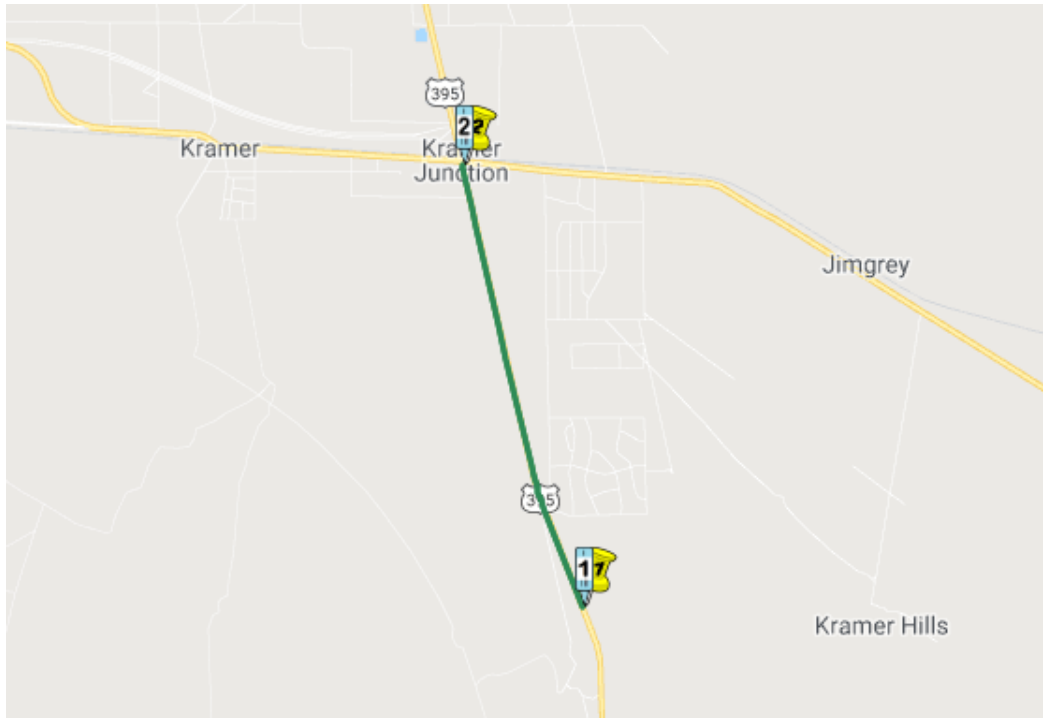
