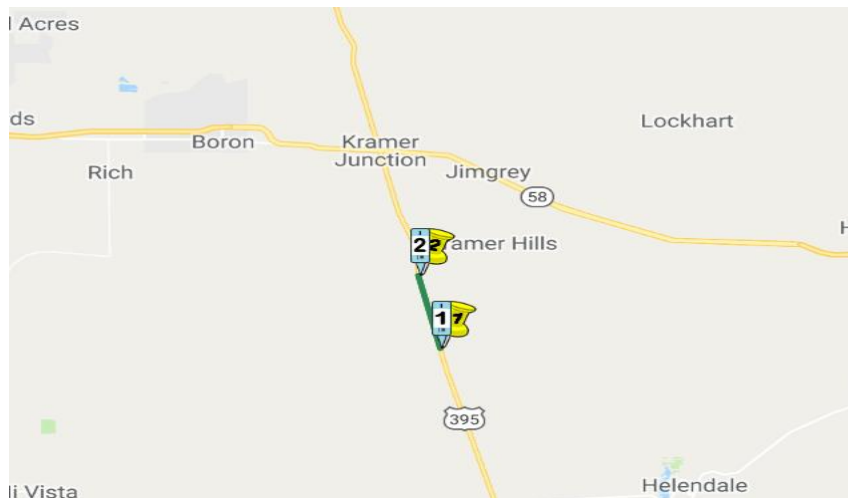

UPDATE: SHOULDER WIDENING PROJECT CONTINUES ON US-395 SOUTH OF KRAMER HILLS

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue the safety operation south of Kramer Hills on United States Highway 395 (US-395). This \$25 million project will include a median buffer, widening shoulders to state standards, and installation of a centerline and rumble strips. This construction project is expected to end in Spring of 2021.

A flagging operation will be in place from April 29 – May 3 from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Please remember to reduce your speed in the work zone.
